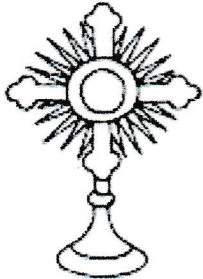
- 1) How do we act in Church?
 - a. Respectful of God's House of Worship
 - b. Walking
- 2) Items of Importance
 - a. **Holy Water**
 - i. This is water that has been blessed It is used to remind us of our baptism
 - ii. When we enter the Church, we are going to lightly dip our finger on our right hand and make the Sign of the Cross
 - b. **Genuflect**
 - i. We Genuflect to show respect in Church. We will Genuflect to the tabernacle before we enter our pew and sit down.
 - ii. We Genuflect at the end of mass before we turn to leave the Church
 - iii. Who do we honor when we Genuflect? **Jesus**
 - c. **Tabernacle**
 - i. The container in which the blessed sacrament is kept so that Holy communion can be taken to those that are sick and can't attend mass
 - d. **Altar**
 - i. The table in the Church on which the priest celebrates mass. On this table the bread and wine are offered to God and become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ
 - e. **Confessional**
 - i. This is where we go to make our Confession or Sacrament of Reconciliation
 1. **Confession**
 - a. Is the act of telling our Sins to the Priest
 2. **Penance**
 - a. This is what we do after confession
 - b. This shows God that we are turning away from Sin and we can live as God wants us to live
